

Attach silicon border to mask

WARNING

DO NOT USE ALCOHOL OR SOLVENT TO CLEAN THE EQUIPMENT

USE A MULTI-SURFACE **DESINFECTANT AND RINSE UNDER THE TAP**

Place the liquid to be nebulized inside



Connect the cup to the controller

USE DESTILLED WATER AND A FEW DROPS OF DETERGENT TO CLEAN THE CUP




Turn on by pressing and releasing the gray button





 Attach the nebulizer set to the mask



If the equipment is on and does not generate aerosol, check that no liquid drops have accumulated at the bottom of the cup. Dry with a paper napkin or cotton swab.



- Green led on indicates equipment running and battery charged.
- Green led flashing every one second indicates low battery.
- Green led flashing quickly and turning off, indicates empty battery. Charge needed.



- Blue led flashes every one second for four times and the devices turns off, indicating cup out of liquid.
- Blue led flashing quickly and the device turns off, indicating disconnected, loose or damaged cup.
- Blue led flashes quickly every two seconds and the device is on, indicating turbo mode activated.
